Region 57 “101” Scholarship

PURPOSE

The purpose of the ”101” Scholarship is to assist high school students and/or returning adult students attend college or technical training.

AVAILABILITY

How many, if any scholarships are provided each year depends solely on the success of the scholarship fundraising efforts. All profits from annual efforts will be used for Region 57 scholarships.

APPLICANT:

Attached is an application form for the International Police Association Region 57 “101” Scholarship. You must complete the application and submit it to the Scholarship Committee no later than July 1 to be considered for the fall semester. You may apply for the scholarship every year, however you may only receive the scholarship every two years unless lack of applicants permits additional funding.

ELIGIBILITY:

This scholarship is open to any student with priority given to Region 57 members as well as children and grandchildren of Region 57 members. All applicants who are not a member of Region 57, must have a region 57 member “sign off” on the application.

The IPA is looking for scholarship candidates who best exemplify the IPA motto of “Service Through Friendship” both in their school and/or community. Award winners will be chosen not only for their school marks but also for their dedication to community as well.

SUBMISSION:

Please include with the application a 500 to 1,000-word narrative telling the committee why they should award this scholarship to you. At least one letter of recommendation is required (from a teacher if high school student) Optional items you may include: resume, descriptions of any volunteer work, school activities, involvement in outside groups. In other words provide anything that demonstrates why you deserve the award and how the IPA “service through friendship” motto describes you. If you or you family has any association to law enforcement, please include that information.
