IPA ACCOMMODATION IN BELGIUM

In the spirit of Servo per Amikeco, for about 20 years now, my wife and I welcome guests and have room available in our house to lodge IPA-members and their family passing through, or for a holiday stay. There are two spacious rooms with own bathroom, suitable for a whole family up to six persons. All beds are single beds. To help us cover the expense, we ask a contribution of 17 Euros per person per night (children 8,50 Euros). For that price you get "bed and breakfast", including fresh bed sheets, towels, heating, final cleaning and of course an extended breakfast.

Torhout is a small city nearby Brugge (18km), the Northsea (25km), Ieper (30 km) and major cities like Gent (B) and Lille (F) are at 55 km or 40 minutes drive by car. Our house is situated at 1 km from the railway station in a quiet neighbourhood.
